MEMBERSHIP?

HOW DOES BOAT MEMBERSHIP WORK?



New Wave Club Boat Memberships are designed for people looking to enjoy Boating without the cost and hassle associated with ownership.

A new member will be put on a 2 day RYA Powerboat Level 2 Course to give them the skills and competence to enjoy our fleet of boats, then further boat specific inductions to make sure they are comfortable across the different vessels. This is done in house by our RYA Training team which has successfully be training new boaters for over 16 years.

Members can then enjoy the boats, taking out friends / family without the supervision of a skipper.

Once signed up members pay a fixed monthly fee + the fuel they use each session, we cover Mooring, Insurance, Maintenance, Depreciation, Harbour Permits.

HOW OFTEN CAN I GET OUT ON THE WATER?

- Members receive 8 sessions per month, 4 Weekend & 4 Weekday. Everyday is broken down to 3 sessions, sunrise - 12.00 , 12.30 - 16.30, 17.00 - 1 hr Pre Sunset. Back to back sessions can be booked if longer time on the water is required.
- If members use up all their sessions additional ones can be booked within 24 hours via the booking app for a fee of £60.

WHAT IS AVAILABILITY LIKE?

This is the number one question we get asked. In short it is great. We monitor membership numbers to ensure this stays like this. We are so confident of this we are happy to put you in touch with current members.

We have two different membership options available for those looking for just Boating. Please note the joining / training fee is only paid on initial signup and not consecutive years at renewal. Please chat to us about options if possibly considering a membership through your business as this is very popular amongst our members.

PADDLEBOARDS & TENDER

Members have access to two PaddleBoards to take out on the boats as well as a Tender should they want an easier way to row ashore when at anchor.



OUR LOCATION

New Wave Club Home Base is Port of Poole Marina, Poole Harbour.

This is the closest Marina to the main channel and an ideal spot for exploring the harbour and or local coastline including the stunning jurassic coast.

3 Big Advantages of our Location :

- Boats are available to use at all states of tide, even a spring low.
- No bridges to wait for and therefore having to time your departure and return
- Centrally located in harbour, so just a short distance to either head out onto coastline or explore around the back of the islands.

FAQS

How does it work?

All Boat memberships are based on an annual 12 month contract. Members can sign up at any point of the year. Our RYA Powerboat Training runs all year round to assist in this process.

How many sessions do I get?

Every Member will be allocated 4 weekend (Peak) and 4 weekday (off-peak) sessions per month.

Everyday is broken down into 3 sessions - (Sunrise - 12.00) (12.30 - 16.30) (17.00 - one hour before sunset) Back to Back sessions can also be booked if you require a full day out on the water.

Please note the boats can not be operated in the dark so morning and evening session length will vary slightly in length but the majority of usage will fall within British Summer Time so should give plenty of before and after work session opportunities.

Members can purchase additional sessions (£60 per session for Gold boats and £150 for the Axopar) if required within a 24 hour period and a Boat is free.

How do I book my sessions?

We continually invest in our bespoke Booking App based booking system to give members an even better experience and flexibility.

When you join you will be given access to the booking system which is optimised to work on a phone/tablet or computer. Once your session is booked you will simply collect your key from our secure Key safe for your session.

What is availability like?

This is the number one question we get asked, the short answer is fantastic.

We closely monitor our vessel to member ratios, and have developed our booking system to suit allow members to book up to 2 months in advance or last minute even after a session has started.

We have been running our Jetski and Boat Club since 2009 and have gained valuable experience of how to provide the best service for our members.

If still undecided we would be happy to put you in touch with some of our current members.

Are there any other costs involved?

The only other cost involved will be that of the fuel you use. At the end of every session each member will be responsible for recording the fuel they use. If under 50 Ltrs we will refuel the boats for you at the local Marina Fuel Rate. If over 50 Ltrs we request you refuel or we can do it but add a £30 surcharge.

We also take a £1000 damage security deposit for Gold Boat Membership or £2000 for Platinum Boat Membership, please remember this is a deposit and should you not damage the boat in any way it will be returned to you at the end of your membership.

Can I put the membership through my business?

Yes, this is a very common practice across our boat members, please check with your own accountant for further information.

Can members tow waterskiers, wakeboarders or inflatables behind the Boats?

Yes you can tow waterskier and wakeboarders if additional training is undertaken. Unfortunately we do not allow you to tow inflatables behind the boats.

FAQS

Is there any safety equipment on the boats?

All our club boats are either MCA Coded or local council coded and therefore carry a full range of safety equipment on board including lifejackets. The only additional safety equipment you may require is lifejackets for children.

How many people can I take on the boats with me?

Please take a look at our fleet information as this varies per boat.

I have already completed my RYA Powerboat Course, does this reduce my joining fee?

It will reduce the joining fee by 15% but despite completing the Course we still like to spend a couple of sessions getting you comfortable with the boats in the club and the local area with one of our experienced RYA instructors. Our Flagship vessel Nixie also requires additional training sessions to become competent on the larger size boat.

Can I roll my sessions over if I don't use them?

No unfortunately your unused sessions will not roll over to the next month.

What happens if I damage a boat?

Members will be responsible to check over the boats thoroughly at the start of each session. Should they cause any damage through improper use they will be liable to meet the full cost of repairs.

How far in advance can I book a session and can I cancel one if required?

Members are able to book sessions up to two months in advance.

Should you wish to cancel a session this can be done up to 24 hours in advance and your allowance returned. If cancelled within 24 hours and another member books up the slot the credit would also be returned.

Can I share a membership with a family member/co Director?

Yes we offer a dual membership where two family members or co business owners can share a membership. There is an additional annual fee for this of £1200

What is the minimum age for a membership?

All boat members must be aged 21 years or over to join the Gold Boat Membership or 25 years or over to join the Platinum Boat Membership

Can I use the boats in the winter months?

Yes absolutely. With some warm gear on, a relaxed speed limit through the Harbour Nov – March, and much less traffic out on the water, some of the best days on the sea can be through this time of year. The boats will be scheduled for maintenance through the winter months so will not always be available during this period.

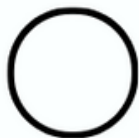
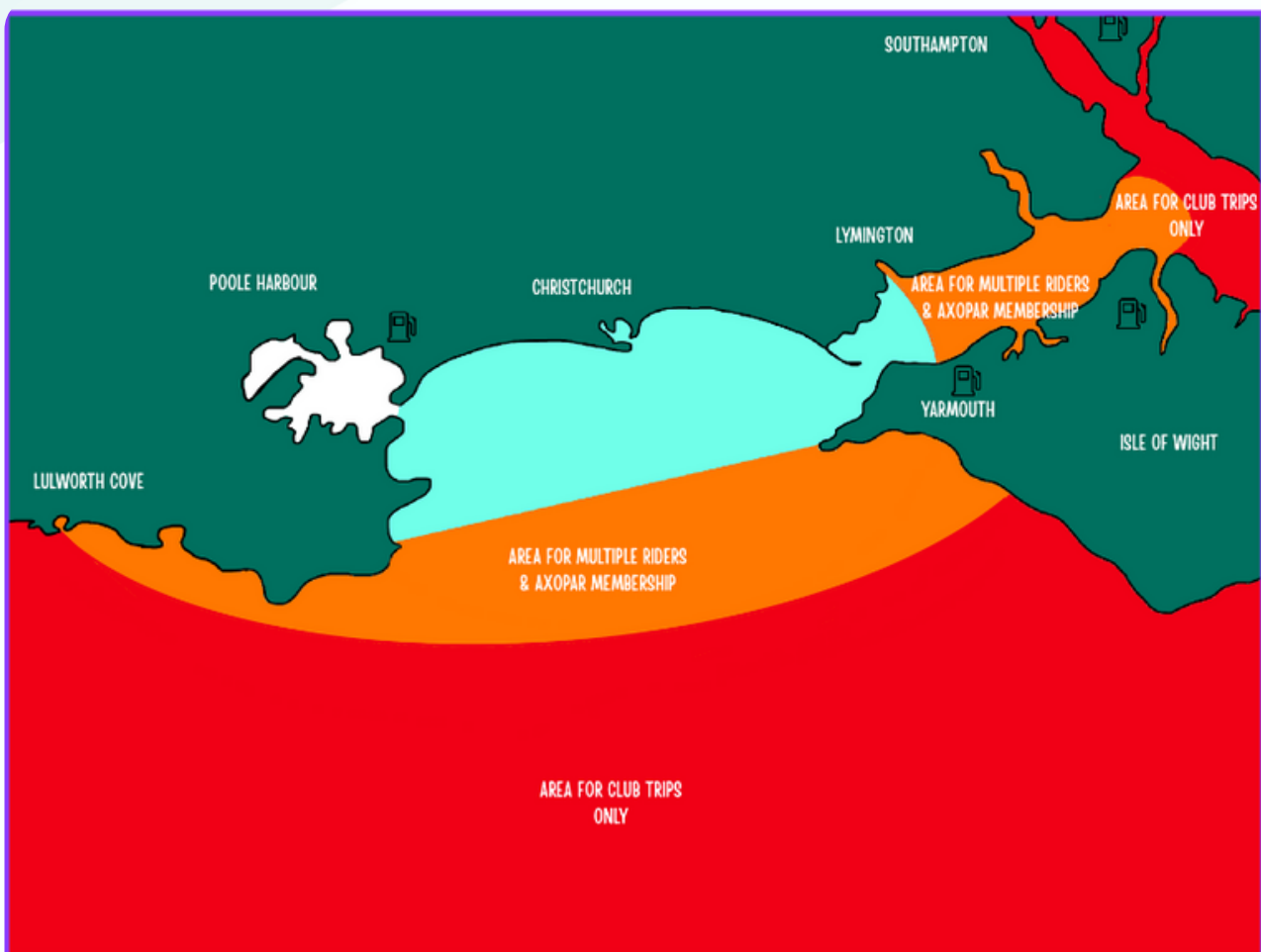
Where can I take the boats?

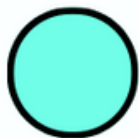
Zone A - Poole Harbour - All Boats
